





Thanks to generous support from Dr. Christine Olsen and Mr. Robert Small, Kingsley has partnered with Lesley University's Center for Mathematics Achievement on an exciting multi-year initiative to evaluate our curriculum, recommend enhancements, and support faculty in providing our students the gold-standard in mathematics education.

Directed by Dr. Hilary Kreisberg, the Center for Mathematics Achievement supports teachers, coaches, specialists, teacher leaders, and administrators nationally and internationally to provide students access to the highest quality mathematics teaching and learning. Working with Tara Hofherr, Director of Elementary Education and Next School Counseling, and Claire Harris, Assistant Director of Elementary Education, Dr. Kreisberg and her team have developed a strategic plan to "position students as analytical thinkers and creative problem solvers, instilling core skills students will need when they leave Kingsley." After observing our classrooms, Dr. Kreisberg noted Kingsley's nurturing environment and the "peace, comfort, and warmth" of our classrooms.
